

What is semaglutide?

Semaglutide is a prescription medication that is taken by injection. When combined with a reduced calorie diet and regular physical activity, it is the safest, most effective way to lose excess weight and keep it off.

How does it work?

Semaglutide is designed to imitate the body's naturally occurring hormone, GLP-1. GLP-1 is a hormone that helps in insulin production and can reduce your appetite by making you feel fuller, sooner.

Is it effective?

Yes! Clinical trials have shown that a weekly dosage of semaglutide, along with a reduced calorie diet and increased physical activity showed an average body weight reduction of 5% around month 3, and 10% around month 6 in study participants.

Patients saw up to 4 pounds weight loss every week. Patient results can be different depending on semaglutide dosage and following provider recommendations for



a healthy diet and exercise.

Is it safe?

Yes! Research has shown semaglutide to be safe and effective, with typically fewer than 5% of patients



experiencing mild to moderate side effects.

The most common mild side effects are nausea, vomiting, bloating and heartburn, and can also include diarrhea, abdominal pain, headache, constipation,

hypoglycemia, dizziness, and flatulence. Dosages can be adjusted weekly to reduce any unwanted effects. Sometimes an anti-nausea medication may be prescribed if necessary.

Rare, but more serious side effects can occur. Additional drug interactions and contraindications may apply. Ask us about any of these conditions during your initial consultation.

Do I qualify for prescription semaglutide injection?
